ARTICLE I

Excavations

Sec. 11-1. Preparation and approval of rules and regulations.

A complete set of rules and regulations may be prepared by the Street Superintendent and approved by the Board of Trustees describing the procedures, precautions and specifications under which excavation work and backfilling shall be done under the provisions of this Article and any other provisions deemed necessary to the best interests of the Town in connection therewith. (Ord. 215 §1, 1993)

ARTICLE II

Encroachments

Sec. 11-21. Unlawful obstructions.

Except as otherwise provided in this Code, it shall be unlawful for any person to obstruct a street or sidewalk with any debris, lumber, sand, gravel, dirt, abandoned or wrecked automobile or other material or substance without first obtaining a permit from the Town Administrator. Such permit may be granted only where the obstruction is necessary for the construction, alteration or repair of the adjoining property, and such permitted obstructions shall be limited to as short a time as is reasonably possible. Each day that an unlawful obstruction is permitted to exist shall constitute a separate and distinct offense. (Ord. 215 §1, 1993)

Sec. 11-22. Removal of snow or ice.

It shall be unlawful for any owner or occupant of any lot, block or parcel of ground within the Town, or any agent in charge of such property, to allow any snow or ice to accumulate or remain upon any sidewalk alongside such property longer than twenty-four (24) hours from the time of the last accretion of such snow and ice.
